

WRITING REVIEW:

1. Take the Post Semester Diagnostic on RaiderWriter.
2. Discuss your pre and post semester diagnostic scores in relationship to each other.
3. Write a thesis statement that helps readers understand what you will focus on in the review of your experiences this semester.
4. Discuss any assignments and commentary, class notes, or in-class activities that illustrate what you have learned about academic writing and what you understand about it that wasn't clear to you before.
 - Give specific examples supporting your thesis statement
5. Discuss what kinds of challenges the tasks/assignments this semester posed for you.
 - Give specific examples that help you illustrate your thesis.
 - Ex: You can discuss specifically what you have learned about summarizing and paraphrasing texts, about analyzing texts and issues.
6. Discuss what you have learned about grammar and mechanics that has helped you become a stronger writer in that respect.
7. You should also talk about other learning experiences you've encountered during the course.
8. Discuss how the work you've done in 1301 has or has not transferred to the writing you have been asked to do in other courses this semester.
